Il Timothy 3:16-17 <u>All scripture</u> is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: that the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.


Titus 1:1-2 Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness; In hope of eternal life, which *God, that cannot lie*, promised before the world began;

Hebrews 6:17-18 God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath: That by two immutable things, in which *it was impossible for God to lie*, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:

- 27% of the Scriptures were predictive prophecy when written. c.1,817 prophecies in the Bible c.50% fulfilled.
- Note: Deuteronomy 18:22; I Kings 22:28; Jeremiah 28:9.



Augustine



Augustine of Hippo A.D. 354 – 430 [Aurelius Augustinus Hipponensis]

Born in Algeria, North Africa.

Lived a hedonistic lifestyle in youth and early manhood.

- Involved with Manichaeism [based on local Mesopotamian religious movements and Gnosticism] in his youth.
- Moved to Milan where he studied Neo-Platonism.
- He had friend who encouraged him towards Catholicism.
- Further, contact with Ambrose of Milan affected him greatly.
- He professed conversion 386 AD aged 31and was baptized by Ambrose.
- ✤ Became Bishop of Hippo c395-430 AD.
- ✤ A prolific scholar.



Sir Isaac Newton 1643 - 1727

In his later years, he devoted much time to the interpretation of the prophecies of <u>Daniel</u> and <u>St.</u> <u>John</u>, and to a closely related study of ancient chronology. Both works were published after his death.




The Seven Churches

- 3. Seven messages to first century AD assemblies, the details of which have a remarkable correspondence with the conditions prevailing during the last 2,000 years of Church history.






