





## **The Mosaic Covenant**

- Mosaic Covenant Exodus 19-24 [Note: 19:5-6]
- The Blessings and Curses of the Mosaic Covenant Leviticus 26 & Deuteronomy 28
- The Mosaic Covenant Follows the Structure of a Suzerain, Vassal Treaty
- The Vassal promises to come under the protective custody of the Suzerain
- The Suzerain promises blessing or curse conditional on the Vassal demonstrating loyalty or disloyalty by obedience or disobedience.




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## **Abomination of Desolation**

Daniel 9:27 ... in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate [desolator].

#### 167 BC Antiochus IV Epiphanes – Seleucid King:


- > Ordered that an altar to the Greek god Zeus be constructed in the Jewish temple.
- > Ordered that swine and other unclean animals were to be sacrificed in the temple.
- > Ordered that the sabbath should be profaned and circumcision was to be abolished.
- Judas Maccabeus, a Jewish priest led the Maccabean Revolt against the Seleucid empire 167-160 BC
- Hanukkah (dedication) commemorates cleansing of the temple and the restoration of Jewish worship 164 BC – NOTE: John 10:22-24

#### Daniel 9:24-27

<sup>24</sup> Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.

<sup>25</sup> Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be *seven weeks*, and *threescore and two weeks*: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

<sup>26</sup> And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.
<sup>27</sup> And he shall confirm the covenant with many for *one week*: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.



#### Daniel 9:24-27

- v.24 weeks = multiple of 7 in this case 1 week = 7 years
- ✤ v.24 70 weeks = 70 x 7 = 490 years
- v.24 thy people Israel
- v.24 thy holy city Jerusalem
- v.25 Commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem 1<sup>st</sup> Nisan [14<sup>th</sup> March], 445 BC Given to Nehemiah by King Artaxerxes [Nehemiah 2:1-8]
- v.25 Messiah the Prince The Lord Jesus Christ
- ✤ v.25 7 weeks [i.e. 7 x 7 = 49 years] completion of restoration of Jerusalem
- V.25 62 weeks [i.e. 62 x 7 = 434 years] the time from completion of Jerusalem until Christ entered Jerusalem on a donkey – Commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem – 1<sup>st</sup> Nisan [14<sup>th</sup> March], 445 BC.
- Thus 49 years + 434 years = 483 years the time from the commandment to build Jerusalem until Christ entered Jerusalem on a donkey.
- ✤ v.26 The 'prince that shall come' double fulfilment:
  - ✤ A. Roman General Titus 70 AD v.26
  - ✤ B. Antichrist v.27
- \* v.27 the covenant a treaty between Antichrist and Israel guaranteeing protection for Israel.

Commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem – 1<sup>st</sup> Nisan [14<sup>th</sup> March], 445 BC


1<sup>st</sup> Nisan, 445 BC + 7 Weeks [49 Years] = Building of Jerusalem complete


49 years + 62 Weeks [434 years] = 483 Years Christ entered Jerusalem

#### After Daniel 9:24-27

- ☆ Daniel 6<sup>th</sup> Century BC
- $\bigstar$  Judah is restored to the land.
- $\bigstar$  They are cured of idolatry.
- ★ Their relationship with God is increasingly cold and careless. See: Malachi
- ★ Despite this God gives hope The Sun of Righteousness will arise Malachi 4:2
- ★ The nation becomes Lo-ammi [Hosea 1:9] God goes quiet for 400 years.
- ★ ...when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son... Galatians 4:4
- ★ Christ offered the Kingdom to the nation Matthew 4:17; Luke 10:1,10-11
- ☆ Eventually He entered Jerusalem 483 years to the day, accepting the adulation befitting a king [Matthew 21:1-11; John 12:12-15], but they had registered their rejection of Him in unbelief [Matthew 12:24,13:1; John 12:37].







## **Israel During the Tribulation**




